

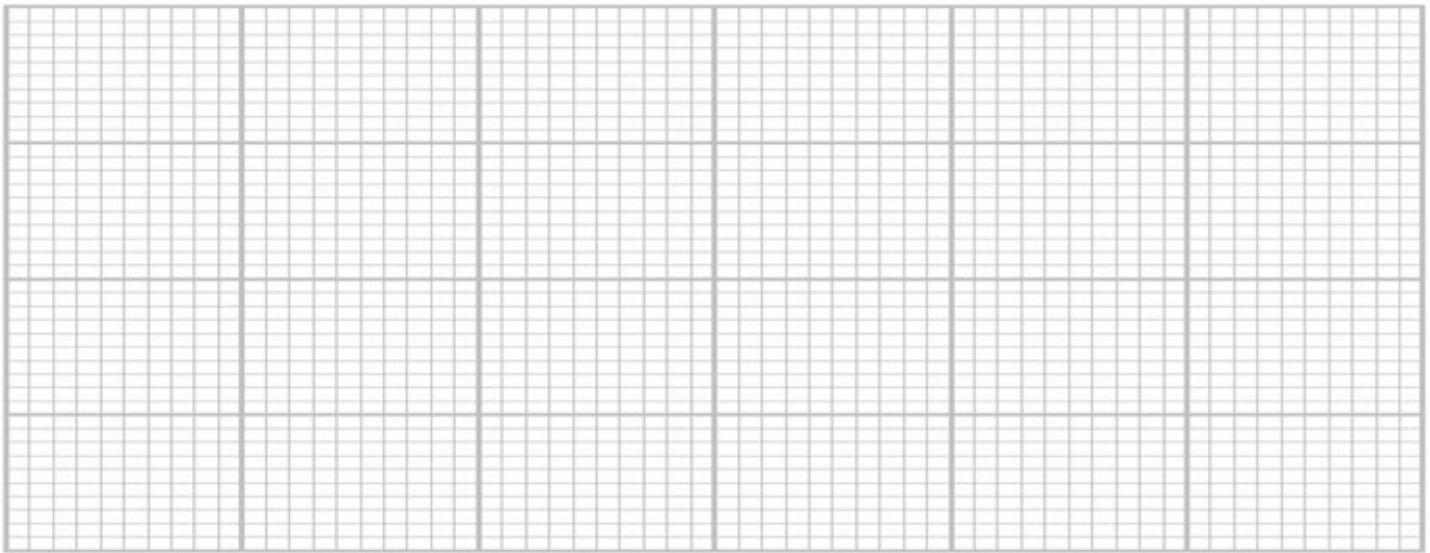
Countertop Estimation Worksheet

Please use the worksheet to complete a rough measurement of your new countertop project. Bring your countertop estimation worksheet with you when you visit the Kitchen & Countertop Center of New England to choose your stone. For any questions please contact KCCNE at (401) 736-0001

1. - Choose Material: Granite | Marble | Quartz | Solid Surface | Formica
 a. Backsplash Option: Y / N Backsplash Size _____ (ie. 3" or 4")

2. - Please draw representation of your countertop in the grid below.
 (Be sure to include the length and depth)

3. - Create drawings into squares and rectangles, sectioning them off and numbering them (1, 2, 3 etc). Include any and all drawings and dimensions for islands (with overhang), proper penninsula overhang, bar tops, fireplace surrounds and window sills. Please label all separate sections accordingly.



4. - Calculate Square Footage:
 a. Measure each section of your existing countertop in inches and record the length and depth in the chart to the right.
 b. Calculate the figures of each section to get the proper area.
 c. Add together all of your calculations to receive our total square inches.
 d. Take your total square inches and divide by 144 to receive your total square footage.
